

Arkansas Marriage Officiant Guide

Marriage Officiants: Any regularly-ordained minister or priest of any religious sect or denomination may perform marriage ceremonies in Arkansas. **Prior to performing a ceremony, Officiants must file their ordination credentials with a county or circuit court clerk in the state, who will then issue a certificate to the minister.** (The filing fee is usually \$5. Please contact your local County Clerk's office for an application and complete instructions.)



PLEASE NOTE: Some County Clerks in Arkansas do not accept ordination credentials bearing an expiration date. In such cases, the church will provide you with a letter of good standing complying with this stipulation.

Certificate of Marriage: Ministers *must* complete the information required in the Certificate of Marriage section on the marriage license. The minister is *not* responsible for returning the license after the marriage ceremony. The applicants are responsible and *must* return the marriage license to the County Clerk's office to be recorded *within sixty (60) days* from the date of issuance.

MARRIAGE LICENSE INFORMATION

This information is meant as a guide only. Much of the information below is state law in Arkansas; however, this information can vary from county to county, and is subject to change. We recommend contacting your county clerk's office before applying for your marriage license.

ID Requirement: Picture ID, such as driver's license, *and* birth certificate. If no birth certificate is available, you will need three forms of identification with name and birth date available on each document.

Application Requirement: Both parties to the marriage must appear in person at the time of applying for the marriage license.

Residency Requirement: You do not have to be a resident of Arkansas.

Waiting Period: No waiting period.

Fees: \$35 (cash only).

Other Tests: No additional tests are required.

Age Requirement: Any applicant under the age of 18 requires consent of both sets of parents.

Proxy Marriage: Not permitted in Arkansas.

Same-Gender Marriage: Permitted following U.S. Supreme Court decision of 26 June 2015.

Valid: An Arkansas marriage license is valid for 60 days. The marriage license can only be used (solemnized) within the State of Arkansas.
